Selects Site For 2020 Rear Admiral Richard E. Bennis Award

The late Rear Admiral Bennis began his career in 1972 as a graduate of the University of Rhode Island. He went on to serve as Captain of the Port Charleston, S.C., and Hampton Roads, Va. On September 11, 2001, while serving as Captain of the Port New York, Rear Admiral Bennis organized the extraordinary waterborne evacuation of nearly 500,000 people from lower Manhattan after the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center. Rear Admiral Bennis served honorably in the Coast Guard for 30 years until his retirement in 2002.
