As the Delta and other COVID variants add new concerns to our workplace environment, we are reminding employees that while many workers are vaccinated, others are not. Although we continually strive to keep our workforce safe, it is our hope that we will not have to reinstate any COVID protocol restrictions. However, we will continue to monitor the CDC, State and Local government guidelines and adjust as necessary.

The CDC has labeled the Delta “a variant of concern” and states that it has been shown that this variant:

- Spreads more easily than other strains of COVID-19.
- Causes increased hospitalizations and deaths.

Key to Prevention Steps, according to the CDC



If you have been vaccinated: Prevention measures not needed. (Although regular handwashing is one of the best ways to remove germs, avoid getting sick, and prevent the spread of germs to others.)

(If you have a condition or are taking medications that weaken your immune system, you may NOT be fully protected even if you are fully vaccinated. Talk to your healthcare provider. Even after vaccination, you may need to continue taking all precautions)



Unvaccinated People: Take prevention measures. Wear a mask, stay 6 feet apart, and wash your hands.

- Safety levels assume the recommended prevention measures are followed, both by the individual and the venue (if applicable).
- CDC cannot provide the specific risk level for every activity in every community. It is important to consider your own personal situation and the risk to you, your family, and your community before venturing out.
